

**POLICY FOR INTERESTED PARTIES REGARDING THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA IN
ACCORDANCE WITH THE EUROPEAN GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION
(General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679)**

We would like to inform you that Article 13 of EU Regulation 2016/679 provides for the protection of individuals and other entities regarding the processing of personal data.

MOVECO S.r.l., with legal and operational headquarters in Via Arturo Biella, 19, 28075 Grignasco (NO) (hereinafter, the "Owner") in quality of owner of the processing, informs you, in accordance with Article 13 of EU Regulation No. 2016/679 (hereinafter, "GDPR"), that your data will be processed in the following manner and for the following purposes:

1. Subject of the Processing

The Owner processes personal data, both identifying and non-sensitive (in particular, name, surname, company name, address, telephone number, email address, bank and payment details), hereinafter referred to as "personal data" or simply "data", provided by you upon conclusion of contracts for the Owner's services or collected directly from collaborators or via agents and representatives in connection with offers and/or during a business relationship or a supply proposal, during a trade fair, or provided directly by the person of interest when requesting contact or registering on our website to ask for a specific product or service (www.movecosrl.com).

Data may also be collected from third parties, such as, for example, data obtained from external companies for the purpose of commercial information or market research, or from our other customers or suppliers.

2. Processing purposes

Your personal data is processed:

A) without your expressed consent (Article 6(b) and (e) of the GDPR), for the following service purposes:

- to finalize contracts for the Owner's services;
- to fulfil pre-contractual, contractual and tax obligations arising from existing relationships with you;
- to manage administrative, accounting, orders, shipments, invoicing and service activities;
- to comply with obligations provided by law, regulations, EU legislation or an order from the Authority (such as, for example, in relation to anti-money laundering);
- to exercise the Owner's rights, for example the right of defense in legal proceedings;

B) Only with your specific and separate consent (Art. 7 GDPR), for the following Marketing Purposes:

- to send you, via email, post and/or text message and/or telephone, newsletters, commercial communications and/or advertising material regarding products or services offered by the Owner and to assess your level of satisfaction with the quality of services;
- to send you, via email, post and/or text message and/or telephone, commercial and/or promotional communications from third parties (for example, business partners, insurance companies, etc.).

Please, note that if you are already one of our stakeholders, we may send you commercial communications relating to the Owner's services and products like those you have already used, unless you disagree (Article 130(4) of the Privacy Code).

3. Processing methods

The processing of your personal data is carried out by the operations indicated in Article 4 of the Privacy Code and Article 4(2) of the GDPR, specifically: collection, recording, organization, storage, consultation, modification, selection, extrapolation, comparison, use, interconnection, communication, and destruction of data. Your personal data is processed both on paper and electronic and/or automated form.

The owner will process personal data for the time necessary to fulfil the purposes set out above and, in any case, for no longer than 10 years from the end of the relationship for Service Purposes and for no longer than 2 years from the collection of the data for Marketing Purposes.

4. Access to data

Your data may be made available for the purposes set out in Articles 2.A) and 2.B):

- to employees and associates of the Owner, in their capacity as data processors and/or internal data controllers and/or system administrators;
- to third-party companies or other entities (for example, credit institutions, professional studies, consultants, insurance companies providing insurance services, etc.) that carry out outsourced activities on behalf of the Owner, in their capacity as external data processors.

5. Transmission of data

Without the need of express consent (Article 6(b) and (c) of the GDPR), the Owner may transmit your data for the purposes set out in Article 2.A). Without prejudice to communications and disclosures made in compliance with legal obligations, data relating to you may be transmitted in Italy and/or abroad to:

- professionals and consultants, consultancy agencies, factoring companies, credit institutions, debt collection agencies, credit insurance companies, commercial information agencies, and companies operating in the transport sector;
- public and private entities, including following inspections or audits, such as the Tax Authorities, Tax Police, Judicial Authorities, the Italian Foreign Exchange Office, the Labor Inspectorate, Local Health Authorities (ASL), Social Security Agencies, the Chamber of Commerce, etc.;

Your data will not be shared with unauthorized third parties.

6. Data transfer

Personal data is stored on servers located in ITALY, within the European Union.

In any case, it is understood that the Owner, if necessary, shall have the right to move the servers outside the EU. In this case, the Owner hereby ensures that the transfer of data outside the EU will take place in accordance with the applicable legal requirements, subject to the conclusion of the standard contractual clauses provided for by the European Commission. The Owner reserves the right to use cloud services and, in such cases, the service providers will be selected from among those offering adequate warranties, as required by Article 46 of the GDPR 2016/679.

7. Nature of the provision of data and effects of refusal to provide data

The provision of data for the purposes set out in Article 2.A) is obligatory. Without such data, we will be unable to provide you with the Services referred to in Article 2.A).

The provision of data for the purposes set out in Article 2.B) is, however, optional. You may therefore choose not to provide any data or subsequently refuse to provide data already supplied: in this case, you will not be able to receive newsletters, commercial communications and advertising material relating to the Services offered by the Owner. However, you will continue have the right to the Services referred to in Article 2.A).

8. Rights of the data subject

As a data subject, you have the rights set out in Article 7 of the Privacy Code and Article 15 of the GDPR, specifically the rights to:

- A. To obtain confirmation regarding the existence or not of personal data concerning you, even if not yet recorded, and their communication in intelligible form;
- B. to be informed of: a) the origin of the personal data; b) the purposes and methods of processing; c) the logic applied in case of processing carried out with the aid of electronic tools; d) the identification details of the owner, the responsible parties and the designated representative in accordance with Article 3(1) of the GDPR; e) the subjects or categories of subjects to whom the personal data may be transferred or that may become aware of it in their capacity as designated representative within the territory of the State, persons in charge of processing or persons authorized to process the data;

- C. to obtain: a) the updating, rectification or, where the data subject has an interest, the integration of the data; b) the erasure, anonymous transformation or blocking of data processed in violation of the law, including data which no longer need to be retained for the purposes for which they were collected or subsequently processed; c) the certification that the operations referred to in points (a) and (b) have been brought to the attention, including as regards their content, of those to whom the data have been transmitted or diffused, except where this proves impossible or involves a use of means manifestly disproportionate to the right to be protected;
- D. to object, in whole or in part, for legitimate reasons: a) to the processing of your personal data, even if relevant to the purpose for which it was collected; b) to the processing of personal data concerning you for the purposes of sending advertising or direct sales material, or to carry out market research or commercial communications, through the use of automated call systems without the need of an operator, via email and/or through traditional marketing methods by telephone and/or post. Please note that the data subject's right to object, as set out in point b) above, for direct marketing purposes using automated methods extends to traditional methods and that, in any case, the data subject is free to exercise the right to object even only in part. Therefore, the data subject may choose to receive only communication via traditional methods, or only automated communications, or neither type of communication.

Where applicable, you also have the rights set out in Articles 16–21 of the GDPR (right to rectification, right to be forgotten, right to restriction of processing, right to data portability, right to object), as well as the right to complain to the Supervisory Authority.

9. Method of exercising rights

You may exercise your rights anytime by sending:

10. Minors

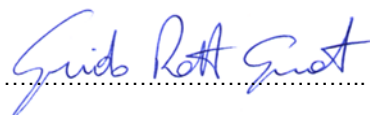
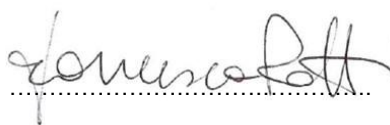
